Uniform Guide

Welcome to Kidderminster college salon, Elements.

We're looking forward to welcoming you to the Hairdressing course this September!

Please take a moment to read through this leaflet, which outlines the required uniform attire for the duration of the course.

If you have any questions about suitable uniform attire, please don't hesitate to get in touch with your tutors:

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Tops:

Your tops must be plain black, free from logos and colour blocks. Good examples would be blouses, shirts, polo tops, etc.

- X No crops tops
- \mathbf{X} No vest tops
- 🖉 Appropriate neck line
- Midriff covered
- 🖉 Cap sleeves at minimum

Shoes:

Your shoes must be plain black, closed toe and flat soled. Good examples would be dolly shoes, loafers, smart black trainers or crocs (no badges).

Please ensure you are wearing black socks with all shoe types.



Jewellery, Hair and Nails:

Following VTCT stipulations, a wedding band and a small pair of stud earrings is the only jewellery allowed during practical sessions. All other jewellery must be removed for practical classes.

All hair below shoulder length must be neatly tied back for practical lessons.

All nails must be well manicured, and extension must be at a reasonable length.

Please see that back of the leaflet for pictures examples of appropriate uniform attire.

Trouser:

Your trouser must be plain black, free from logos and colour block. Good example would be office / school trousers, smart cargos

- 🗙 No skirts or dress
- X No jeans or leggings
- 🧹 Full leg length
- Tapered, straight, flared or cuffed

You will be required to order an apron as part of your uniform. This must be worn at all times in the salon.
