



Kidderminster College is proud to work along side West Midlands Safari Park to offer a range of animal management courses.

The Safari Academy at West Midlands Safari Park is a sustainable, state-of-the-art educational facility which has five fully equipped classrooms, specifically designed for visiting groups and Further Education Animal Care students.

The unique learning environment the Academy offers allows students to get up close and personal with a variety of our smaller animals in our two animal areas. Our outdoor classroom enhances the curriculum linked learning we deliver in a safe and secure environment.




Kidderminster College and Kidderminster Harriers Football Club (KHFC) have a strong partnership that provides educational and football development opportunities.

Students can pursue sport qualifications at various levels, including a Foundation Degree in Physical Education and Sports Coaching.

Students study alongside training with the Harriers Academy, which includes pathways to professional football.

The partnership also offers higher education options, including a Foundation Degree in Football Business Management and Coaching, in collaboration with the University of Worcester.

CONTEXT





Aim & Intent: We will engage with key stakeholders to co-create and deliver an innovative, relevant, student-centred curriculum, aligned to Worcestershire's skills challenges and responsive to employer needs. We will utilise the NCG Guarantee and Worcestershire Employer Standards to provide a structured approach to driving the quality and consistency of skills development and the associated positive impact. Whilst Worcestershire is not yet a devolved authority and has to submit initial proposals by March 2025, the general direction of travel in terms of funding adult education and skills will see a substantial transfer of powers to local unitary authority areas. The college will continue to seek and develop opportunities to support local community responses with the lifespan of this

Adult Skills Budget in order to safeguard future local/devolved skills funding allocations.

Aim & Intent: We will use our position as a credible anchor institution within the Wyre Forest to support social mobility and societal transformation. We will extend our community leadership, working collaboratively to deliver ambitious civic projects and programmes that support widening participation, leading to better prospects for our communities across Worcestershire and attracting students, staff and partners who share our values.
