

Property Maintenance Operative



As a Property Maintenance Operative, you will assist in ensuring that a building's condition is of high quality and in a safe working condition. You will be expected to maintain a high level of quality, providing maximum satisfaction to customers, clients, guests and your team.

You have the potential to work in a variety of industries, for example housing, healthcare, social care, hospitality, education, commercial properties, leisure, retail and public and private sector buildings. You will be trained in the mechanisms of building including electrical, plumbing, plant, safety systems and equipment. You will provide first and immediate response to fault finding and assist in the prevention of major damage that could result in extensive costs and minimise reactive intervention.

When you complete the Property Maintenance Operative apprenticeship programme with its transferable skills, you will be able to progress into a variety of roles such as a Technical Specialist, e.g. electrical or plumbing, and supervisory and management roles, e.g. Facilities Management, across a wide range of sectors.
